


1. Remove the front bumper cover.


Torque: 28 lb.in (3.2 Nm)

4. Disconnect the headlamp assembly electrical connector and remove the headlamp assembly.




6. Disconnect the camera washer hose and plug the washer hose end. Remove the clips and position the washer hose assembly aside.



- 3. Remove the retainer and position the wiring harness aside.




8. Remove the push pins, the screws and the lower air deflector. *Torque*: 18 lb.in (2 Nm)

Torque: 53 lb.in (6 Nm)



All vehicles

1. To install, reverse the removal procedure.

Vehicles With: 360 Degree Camera

2. Align the 360° cameras.
